

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Lowestoft Inner Harbour – Gull Wing Bridge – Official Road Opening and Temporary Navigational Restriction

UTC BST

Mariners and Port Users are advised that the Gull Wing Bridge, Lowestoft Inner Harbour, is scheduled to open to the public on Saturday 7th September 2024.

Schedule of Opening is as follows:-

09:00hrs – Bridge open to pedestrians only.

12:00hrs – Bridge opens to road traffic – normal road traffic will be preceded by a parade of vintage buses across the Bridge.

To accommodate this event, the 09:45hrs and 11:15hrs Gull Wing small boat openings will be cancelled. The first Gull Wing small boat opening on Saturday 7th will be at 14:30hrs.

Vessels with less than circa 10m air draft, or a confirmed air draft clearance of +1.0m, will be permitted to pass under the Gull Wing bridge, subject to permission from the Gull Wing Bridge Operator on VHF Ch14.

Commercial vessel openings on Gull Wing will not be possible between 09:00hrs and 13:30hrs.

Bascule Bridge openings are not affected by the Gull Wing Opening event.

After 13:30hrs the Gull Wing Bridge will be operated as per the published scheme of operation. This can be viewed on the ABP website:
