

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Lowestoft – Tour of Britain Cycle Race – Gull Wing and Bascule Bridge Temporary Navigational Restrictions

UTC BST

Mariners and Port Users are advised that the Tour of Britain Cycle Race is scheduled to set off from Lowestoft on Sunday 8th September. The race is scheduled to commence from Royal Plain at 1100hrs, transit North over the Bascule Bridge, then transit South over the Gull Wing Bridge.

To accommodate this event the 11:15 small boat opening on both the Gull Wing and Bascule Bridges will be postponed to 12:00hrs. Note that this delay will be subject to the cycling event having cleared both bridges. Vessels with less than circa 10m air draft, or a confirmed air draft clearance of +1.0m, will be permitted to pass under the Gull Wing bridge, subject to permission from the Gull Wing Bridge Operator on VHF Ch14.

Commercial vessel Bridge Openings will not be accommodated between 10:30hrs and 12:00hrs on either the Gull Wing or Bascule Bridges.
